Families of Ms. Frascella & Ms. Sokol,

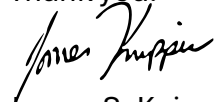
This note is to inform you that there have been cases of Fifth's Disease confirmed in your child's classroom. There is nothing of immediate action on your part, just be on alert if you observe any of the symptoms.

Fifth's disease is a contagious childhood disease that is spread by respiratory droplets and manifests itself by a rash on cheeks that appear as if they have been slapped.

Familias de la Sra. Frascella y la Sra. Sokol,

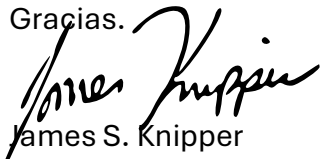
Esta nota es para informarle que ha habido casos confirmados de la enfermedad de Quintos en el salón de clases de su hijo. No hay nada de acción inmediata de su parte, solo esté alerta si observa alguno de los sistemas.

La enfermedad de la quinta es una enfermedad contagiosa de la infancia que se transmite a través de gotitas respiratorias y se manifiesta por una erupción en las mejillas que parecen haber sido abofeteadas.

No hay nada que se pueda hacer para evitar la propagación de la misma y una vez que aparece la erupción, el individuo ya no es contagioso.
